Notice to Competitors

The Friday Test Day and Saturday Practice sessions will end with the checker flag displayed at Start/Finish and all stations displaying Black Flag ALL – Proceed to Pit Lane immediately. All sessions and races are time limited, laps may vary, and schedule can change. Change announcements are made over the PA system and text messages via MSR

- 1. EVENT. This event is an SCCA Regional Race for MARRS & NEDRRC points, Track Day & Track Sprint conducted in accordance with New Jersey Motor Vehicle Racetrack Regulations Chapter 62, the current SCCA General Competition Rules, any amendments to date, MARRS rules and these Supplemental Regulations (the rules). In the event of a conflict, the New Jersey regulations will supersede all others. The Chief Steward has the authority to enforce all rules in the aforementioned documents. It is drivers' responsibility to read, understand and abide by these rules.
- 2. COURSE. 1.9 mile Lightning Raceway course at New Jersey Motorsports Park.
- 3. **OFFICIALS.** See <u>www.sjr-scca.org</u> for complete list of contacts. - 4. ENTRIES. Event entry registration made online at <u>https://sjrscca.motorsportreg.com/events/lightning-challenge-njmp-scca-south-jersey-sjr-club-racing-916421</u>. Online registration will close at 12:00 PM the day prior to the first day of the event. Mailed entries should be addressed to Terri Zane, 14 Richter Road, Tabernacle NJ 08088 and mailed postmarked by May 31. There is no late entry fee. A \$50 fee will be charged for insufficient funds. Failure of payment may result in suspension of membership and license.
- 5. The NJ State Police will not honor the SCCA extension for 2010 SA helmets. Only SA 2015 and SA 2020 helmets for Test Day & Race, M or SA 2015 and M or SA 2020 helmets for Track Day & Track Sprint will be accepted at this event.
- 6. WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS. Refunds are guaranteed for cancellations received by the Registrar electronically prior to the close of event Sunday. Telephone/verbal cancellations will be accepted if followed by written notice as previously noted. Notifications may be given to the Registrar at the track or mailed to Terri Zane. No refunds can be made if the car has participated in any on-track session. Refunds will be processed promptly the week after the event.
- 7. MINORS. Minors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian that will sign a minor waiver or must present a notarized minor waiver or have a current SCCA Annual Minor Waiver. No one under 16 years of age is allowed in the Pit Lane or on the False / Make-Up Grid (Hot Areas). 15 Year old drivers may enter Hot Areas for normal driving activities but otherwise are prohibited from being in hot areas.

IMPORTANT: In order to satisfy New Jersey race regulations under Chapter 62, minor drivers must provide a copy of their birth certificate, an SCCA minor waiver signed by a parent or guardian and a detailed driver resume.

8. **TRACK ACCESS.** No motorized vehicles are allowed on the racecourse or in the pit lane before the start or after the end of the scheduled competition activities on any day of the event.

9. DRIVER ELIGIBILITY.

- <u>Race and Test Day</u> Drivers must be SCCA members with licenses eligible for competition per GCR including SCCA Novice Permit holders with their driver school requirements completed. In addition, holders of licenses listed in GCR Appendix C 2.8.B. will be accepted on the same terms.
- <u>Alternative Driver School</u> Only open to any Road Racing driver holding a current or expired competition license from any sanctioning organization. Drivers must be SCCA members, weekend memberships can be purchased at the event.
- <u>Track Events Track Days</u> Open to all drivers holding a valid driving license from any US state. Drivers must be SCCA members, weekend memberships can be purchased at the event
- <u>Time Trial Track Sprints</u> Open to all drivers holding a valid driving license from any US state. Must be SCCA member with Competition License or time trials permit added (free, just need to request it).
- 10. SIGNAL LIGHT. A three bulb traffic light (2 yellow 1 red bulb) may be used on drivers' right at the entry to Turn 1 to communicate to course (Flag) condition at Turn 1. This light represents the beginning of the no passing zone when a yellow flag condition is indicated. A red light will never be used alone to stop the session or race. Lights representing these flag signals will be displayed as follows:
 - Standing yellow flag (single yellow light)
 - Waving yellow flag (two blinking yellow lights)
 - Double yellow flags (two steady yellow lights)
 - Debris flag (two yellow lights with a red light)

- 11. MARRS CHAMPIONSHIP. This event is a Mid-Atlantic Road Racing Series (MARRS) race. Cars should be marked with the official decals of the MARRS series, one on each side of the car in a prominent place. Decals are available at Tech or from Driver Representative. All qualifying entries are scored for championship points see MARRS Rules. MARRS 2021 Rules. Points will be awarded for the Heat race and the Feature race. If required, series sponsor decals and instructions for displaying them will be available.
- 12. MARRS IMPOUND COMPLIANCE CHECKS. All cars are subject to technical inspection during all MARRS events at the discretion of the chief steward after receiving input from the appropriate driver representative and the Chief of Tech. These inspections will be non-invasive or minimally-invasive, with no bond required. A driver has the right to refuse to submit his car to such an inspection but will forfeit all MARRS points to date. This right to refuse an inspection specifically does not apply to normal GCR supported inspections which will be agreed upon by the chief steward and the Chief of Tech prior to the start of the event, where specific penalties are mandated for refusing an inspection.
- 13. BRACKET SPRINTS. SBRR is a "Run-what-ya-brung" class for all closed wheel and SRF cars based on brackets, like drag racing format. All entries qualify based on best lap time of any qualifying session during the event, up to 8 Brackets may be set based on lap times and you'll race every car around you. Cars must meet SCCA GCR safety rules, vehicle modifications are unlimited. See full rules on SJR-SCCA website: <u>https://www.wdcr-scca.org/bracket-racing</u>
- 14. **GRID POSITIONS.** Qualifying grid is set by earliest entry date and time. Heat Race grid position set by fastest lap in Qualifying Race. Feature Race grid position set by fastest lap in any timed session.
- 15. CREDENTIALS. Access to Hot Areas is limited to SCCA members 16 years of age or older. Crew members who are not members of SCCA are not allowed in the Hot Areas. Crew members requiring access to Hot Areas can purchase a weekend SCCA membership for \$25 or join SCCA at registration. Credentials must be visible in hot areas at all times. Crew Members must be listed on event registration. Only the driver/entrant may change the names of crew listed.
- 16. LICENSING. For licensing and Novice Permit information contact licensing@sir-scca.org
- RACECAR ELIGIBILITY. Open to all categories listed in GCR 9.1 that are eligible for SCCA regional racing. The following region specific classes will also be eligible: GT Pinto (GTP), Improved Touring Endurance (ITE), Improved Touring 7 (IT7), Spec RX-7 (SRX7), Club Ford (CF), Club Formula Continental (CFC), Showroom Spec Miata (SSM), SM2, Spec Miata Tire (SMT), Super Production Over (SPO), Super Production Under (SPU), Spec Boxster (SB).
- a) Specifications for CF, ITE, IT7, SSM, SM2, SMT, SPU, SPO and CFC are on the NEDiv website.

- **18. OVERSUBSCRIPTIONS.** Road Racing Test Day will be limited 52 entries per group. Track Days will be limited to 40 entries per group. Time Trials Track Sprint is limited to 50 entries. All subsequent entries will be placed on a wait list. Entrants will be notified of their status as changes in registration are realized.
- **19. UNDERSUBSCRIPTIONS.** Groups with less than 10 entries may be combined into another group. Groups and Event Sessions can change during the event. You are responsible to be aware of changes.
- 20. QUALIFYING. All qualifying times, grids and provisional results will be posted in Registration.
- 21. RESULTS AND TROPHIES. Session and race results will be posted in Registration. Trophies will be awarded in accordance with GCR 3.6.2 except as noted below and must be picked up at the track. Trophies will not be mailed unless official results have not been posted by 6:30 PM the day of the race.

- 22. SOUND CONTROL. Sound Control is in effect. The 2021 sound limit is 103 db. Whenever possible, a sign board with the word 'Sound' and a car number will be displayed at Start/Finish the first time that a reading over 103db is reported. This display, or lack thereof, is informational only and is not protestable. Sound readings will be posted in the registration.
- 23. TECH INSPECTION. Tech inspection will be conducted at the Tech Garage in the paddock area. All racecars must have an Annual Tech Inspection prior to participation in any on track sessions. The drivers must present helmet, safety gear and SCCA logbook at Tech Garage for inspection after registration. Drivers must complete their tech sheet including the page number from the appropriate spec book listing their car. You must have proof of registration to get a tech sticker.

NJ 62-3.6 requires all drivers to wear a full-face helmet with a face shield - open face helmets and helmets without full face shields are prohibited.

- 24. SAFETY BELTS. Your safety belts <u>MUST MEET THIS REQUIREMENT</u> NJ 62-3.7.c.1 specifies that seatbelts certified under SFI 16.1 or 16.5 <u>expire</u> on 31 December of the second year after the date of manufacture; all other provisions of GCR 9.3.19 apply. Per Chapter 62, the NJMP staff and/or members of the New Jersey State Police (NJSP) may perform random tech inspections to ensure compliance with Chapter 62. All participants are required to comply with any such random inspection and any finding of NJMP and/or the NJSP, and all findings are final and not protestable to SJR-SCCA.
- **25. SCALES.** The scales will be available at the Tech Garage as listed in the schedule.
- 26. CAR NUMBERS. MARRS preferred numbers will be honored until <u>3 days prior to event</u>. All car numbers will be assigned by the Registrar and verified at Tech Inspection. Conflicting car numbers will be resolved at registration. Three digit car numbers are not permitted without the approval of the Chief of Timing & Scoring.
- 27. TIMING & SCORING. MyLaps Transponder System will be used at this event. A working transponder must be mounted on each car, with only one car registered for each transponder. It is the competitors' responsibility to notify Timing & Scoring of their transponder number by writing it on the T&S section of the entry form or by reporting to T&S in person. Non-official timing lights may not be before and within 30 feet of Start/Finish timing line. Timing and Scoring information on systems other than SJR Timing, if in use, are unofficial and cannot be used to support a protest. Cars without a functioning transponder, or whose numbers do not meet the approval of Timing & Scoring, may not be timed.
- 28. PITS. During races a maximum of two people per car are permitted at the outer pit wall after the start to time and signal cars. The pit lane may be crossed carefully during a race. No smoking or alcoholic beverages are permitted in the pits. Tank tops and open toe shoes are prohibited in the hot pit area, shorts are prohibited over the wall in the Pit Lane. Minors under 16 are not permitted in the pits.
- 29. DRIVERS MEETINGS. There are Mandatory driver meetings, by race group, immediately after each qualifying session on Saturday in the classroom.
- **30. MAKEUP GRID.** Crew members must clear the Makeup Grid at the one minute signal. Late starters shall obey the orders of the Grid and Pit Marshals as to how and when to enter the course. No smoking permitted while cars are on the Makeup Grid. Minors under 16 are not permitted on the Makeup Grid. Makeup Grid is a hot area, closed toe shoes required.
- **31. SPLIT STARTS.** Procedures will be addressed in drivers meeting when appropriate.
- 32. BLACK FLAG. The Black or Mechanical Black Flags ("Meatball") will be displayed at Start bridge and may also be displayed on driver's left at Station 8. Drivers receiving the Black Flag are to proceed to Black Flag station on pit lane where they will be met by an Assistant Chief Steward.
- **33. IMPOUND.** The top three cars in each class must go directly to impound at the Tech Garage and must not be modified from their race condition in any way. Drivers are responsible for determining their finishing positions.
- **34. LAST LAP.** Whenever possible, the last lap of each race may be indicated by the starter showing a white sign with a black "1" to the entire field. This display, or lack thereof, is informational only and is not protestable.
- **35. DAMAGES.** Any participant causing damage to SJR Club equipment or to NJMP facilities, intentionally or by accident or gross negligence as determined solely by the event officials, is financially liable for the resulting replacement or repair. If oil dry is dispensed by NJMP or SJR, the participant that leaked the fluid will be charged for all bags of oil dry at \$15 per bag, less 1 bag paid for by SJR. Your credit card will be charged at the event for all damages unless other payment is arranged during the event.
- **36. BIT Lottery**. The SJR may offer any number of closed wheel drivers a No Charge entry into the Bracket Sprint group. To be eligible for this entry, mark Bracket Sprint Lottery Eligible on the entry form.

37. LAST LAP. When the checker flag is displayed at the end of each session a **Black Flag** may be displayed at all flag stations, all participants are to exit the course immediately to Pit Lane.

ALTERNATE DRIVER SCHOOL - STUDENTS ONLY - 21-ADS-20588

38. ELIGIBILITY – Alternate Driver School – Only open to any Road Racing drivers holding a current or expired

competition license from any sanctioning organization. Drivers must be SCCA members and have a valid Novice Permit, weekend memberships can be purchased at the event.

39. CLASSROOM SESSION. Unless specifically excused by the Chief Steward, all students in the Alternative Driver School regardless of previous experience and current license, must attend the classroom session on the Thursday evening at 7:00 PM of the event weekend or at other times in the Event Schedule. This session will be held at the Lightning classroom. Unexcused absence may result in the driver not being permitted to take part in on-track activities and forfeiture of registration fee.

- **40.** This event is run under the SCCA Track Days rules, the complete rules are listed here and on SCCA Track Days rules: <u>https://www.scca.com/pages/scca-track-events</u>
- 41. CREDENTIALS. Access to Hot Areas is limited to SCCA members 16 years of age or older. Crew members who are not members of SCCA are not allowed in the Hot Areas. Crew members requiring access to Hot Areas can purchase a weekend SCCA membership for \$25 or join SCCA at registration. Credentials must be visible in hot areas at all times. Crew Members must be listed on event registration. Only the driver/entrant may change the names of crew listed.
- 42. TRACK DAY CAR ELIGIBILITY. Open to all cars which are street legal, currently registered vehicles. SUV and pickup trucks may be permitted with Chief of Tech approval. In addition, cars classified by the GCR for SCCA Club Racing as Miata (SM, SSM), Touring (all), Improved Touring (all) and American Sedan, and Solo classes (Stock, Street Touring, Street Prepared and Street Modified) will be allowed. The event is also open to all cars conforming to Trials Level 4 regulations that compete on DOT tires.
- **43. OVERSUBSCRIPTIONS.** Track Days will be limited to 40 entries per group. All subsequent entries will be placed on a wait list. Entrants will be notified of their status as changes in registration are realized.
- 44. SAFETY BELTS. Street legal cars must have a passenger seat with at least a three point seat belt, both meeting DOT standards as a minimum.
- **45. ROLLBARS.** Any car that is street legal will NOT require a roll bar/roll cage, except for Convertibles and Targa top automobiles. Convertibles and Targa top automobiles cars must have either an SCCA Time Trial legal roll bar, a non-mechanical factory roll bar/roll over protection (i.e. no pop-ups), or a factory hard top using the factory mounting hardware and mounting points. The height of any vehicle occupant (with helmet) in an open car shall not be higher than the highest point of a roll bar structure. Owners of cars equipped with factory roll bars/roll over protection must present documentation stating that the device is a roll bar or roll over protection at the time of vehicle tech inspection (a factory issued Owners or Shop Manual will fulfill this requirement.). Rollover protection should be such that all vehicle occupants are able to pass the "broomstick" test when properly seated, belted, and helmeted.

46. PERSONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT.

- a) All participants must be fully covered by clothing when on track (no shorts, no short sleeves, shoes that fully cover the foot, etc.) Fire resistant suits are not required, but are recommended in all race-prepared cars, and optional in all cars.
- b) Helmets must meet a minimum of Snell M or SA 2015 or newer requirements. Drivers in open cars must have a full face helmet. The NJSP will not honor the SCCA extension for 2010 SA helmets. Only SA 2015 and SA 2020 helmets will be accepted.
- **47. DRIVER EXPERIENCE.** Each entrant must provide a complete description of prior driving and competition experience to allow the organizers to develop the appropriate groups. The event Credential Committee (Race Chairman, Chief Steward and Chief Instructor) is authorized to waive the student status for qualified individuals. If you are unsure of experience or status contact the PDX Chairperson or register in the Novice Group.

48. PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS.

- a) Any driver who has the legal authority (license or permit) to operate an automobile on a public road may participate in TRACK DAY events, as long as all restrictions of the driving license or permit are met. If those restrictions require a passenger, that passenger must be an event Instructor assigned by the Chief Instructor; the parent/guardian MUST contact the Chief Instructor to discuss the entrants experience level PRIOR to the event - NO exceptions
- b) All participants, including drivers, workers, crew members and guests must sign the SCCA Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement Form at Registration. New Jersey Motorsports Park also requires their own waiver, signed at the gate, to gain to access their property, this is a separate waiver that is unrelated to the SCCA Waiver. You must sign both waivers! Minors (under 18) are required to have a specific SCCA minor wavier signed and notarized by both parents.
- c) Participants must present their completed TRACK DAY Tech Form and HELMET to Tech Inspectors for approval.
- d) The organizers of this event have the right to refuse an entry at their discretion.
- **46. TECHNICAL INSPECTION.** All entrants must have the attached TRACK DAY Technical Inspection Form **completed** by a mechanic or qualified individual prior to the event. Any vehicles without this form completed may be barred from participation.

There will be a brief Tech Inspection confirmation procedure at the event. Cars with completed forms will be given priority over cars which require a full inspection.

- a) Hardtops and sunroofs must be removed and/or securely fastened. Convertible tops must be fully down and securely fastened.
- b) Brake lights and DOT tires are required on all cars.
- c) A restraint system meeting federal standards for the year of manufacture of the vehicle in each of the front seating positions. At a minimum, a three point system must be in place. Competition type 5-point systems are highly recommended and required in cars modified for racing (e.g. Showroom Stock, Touring, and IT).
- d) Any car that is judged to be in an unsafe operating condition at any time during the event shall be prohibited from further participation until the deficiency is corrected.
- e) All loose items in and out of the car must be removed. Passenger seat back and cushion must be secured.
- 47. TRACK DAY TRACK RULES. During TRACK DAY sessions, passing is permitted only with a point-by for both students and instructors. In the case where a student manages to find themselves with more than two wheels off the track, they will re-enter the track safely (possibly with the assistance of the course workers) and proceed to the Pit area to explain your conduct to the Safety Steward and/or the Chief Instructor. With a second infraction of more than two wheels off the track, you may forfeit the balance of your day (with no refund). This is an educational event and as such, you are expected to drive on the track as instructed. There is no trophy for a wrecked car and this is NOT a racing school; it is an educational event which is designed to help you get up to speed on a closed track safely.
- **48. DISQUALIFICATION.** Drivers are responsible for their guests, crew, and service vehicles. Vehicles may not operate in an unsafe manner on any track access road before or during the event. Drivers may not have unauthorized passengers in the vehicle to or from any area of the course. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed prior to the completion of the day's on-track activities. Violation of these rules may result in disqualification without refund.
- 49. TECH INSPECTION. Each participant must present their pre-event Tech Inspection Form and helmet to the Tech Inspectors for approval. An on-site technical inspection is available but will not necessarily be performed in a timely manner (you may miss your first track session of the day). BRING YOUR COMPLETED DOCUMENTS TO TECH INSPECTION.

- 50. TRACK SPRINT. A Time Trial Sprint event open to all cars meeting the SCCA Time Trials rules: <u>https://timetrials.scca.com/</u>. This event is run under the SCCA Time Trials National Rules. - **51.** The event is a point A to point B on a closed section of the track with a standing start and flying finish and no cones. It allows you to experience corners and speeds you wouldn't experience on lapping sessions and help you master parts of the track you might be struggling with. The event is a standalone event, starting at 6PM Saturday.
- **52. OVERSUBSCRIPTIONS.** Time Trials Track Sprint is limited to 50 entries. All subsequent entries will be placed on a wait list. Entrants will be notified of their status as changes in registration are realized.

- 54. CAMPING. Tent and motorhome camping available without charge.
- 55. QUIET TIME. Unmuffled engines may not be run between 8:00 PM and 8:30 AM.
- 56. TRACK HOURS. The track facilities are available to SCCA starting at 7:00 PM on Thursday evening. All participants must vacate the facility by 7:00 PM on Sunday evening.
- 57. TRACK SECURITY. Security guards are available at the track. The organizers and NJMP will not be responsible for damage or theft of your personal equipment.
- 58. SIGNS. No signs may be posted on any track facility
- **59. VEHICLES.** The speed limit in the paddock is 5 mph. The speed on access roads is 25 mph. Race cars not licensed for street use may not be driven outside of the paddock. Testing or brake bedding on infield roads is prohibited. NJ State Police have authority to ticket violators
- **60. SERVICES.** Electricity, water, compressed air, restrooms and refreshments are available at NJMP. Racing gas will be available from 8:30 am to 5 pm, hours may vary. New Jersey state law requires that all gas be dispensed in RED cans.
- 61. PADDOCK. Cars should be aligned in the paddock under the direction of the paddock marshals. No motorized vehicle

may be operated by anyone not holding a valid state issued driver license. Children must always be under direct parental supervision. Since groups not under SCCA control will have access to the paddock, reasonable care should be exercised to protect personal belongings. Remotely piloted air vehicles, sometimes known as drones, shall not be operated anywhere in the airspace over New Jersey Motorsports Park, we are adjacent to Millville Airport.

- **62. RADIO FREQUENCIES.** Race Operations use radio frequencies 452.2000 and 451.4000 for this event. Teams please do not use these frequencies.
- 63. RACE INFORMATION. Event sessions can change during the event. Listen to announcement broadcast over PA system and on radio FM 105.5 at Lightning.


